MILITARY SPOUSE SCHOLARSHIP

Dear Applicant,

The Fort Knox Spouses Community Club Scholarship Program is a private organization that provides scholarships for deserving, eligible U.S. military family members. Scholarships are awarded based on the student's academic record, work experience, volunteer experience, participation in community-based activities, letters of recommendation and a brief essay.

Financial need is not considered.

All properly submitted applications are reviewed and evaluated by the Scholarship Committee in accordance with the organization's constitution and by-laws. All materials submitted will remain confidential.

1. Eligibility.

A. The applicant must be one of the following:

- a. The spouse of an Active Duty or AGR (Active Guard/Reserve) U.S. military sponsor assigned or attached to Ft. Knox.
- b. The spouse of a deceased or retired member of the U.S. military forces residing in the Fort Knox area*.
- c. The spouse of an Active Duty or AGR (Active Guard/Reserve) U.S. military sponsor residing in the Fort Knox area*.

* Fort Knox area = Fort Knox Housing, Hardin, Meade, or Bullitt Counties.

B. The applicant must be a high school graduate or hold a valid high school equivalent.

C. The applicant must be accepted by an accredited institution of higher learning (i.e., college, vocational, or correspondence) or expect to be accepted by such an institution for an **undergraduate/graduate** degree. Persons pursuing a second undergraduate or graduate degree are **NOT ELIGIBLE**.

D. The applicant must possess a valid U.S. military identification card.

E. Active duty service members are not eligible.

F. Those who have previously applied but did not receive a scholarship are eligible to apply.

2. Procedures.

Applicants must submit the following as a completed packet to be considered by the Selection Committee.

A. Completed Application Form.

- a. Use this year's current application form. Do not send resumes, copies of awards or diplomas. Provide only the information requested.
- b. Ensure the applicant has signed the completed application form.

c. Completed and signed Proof of Active DEERS Enrollment Form verifying the applicant's possession of a current military dependent ID card.

B. Essay.

In 500 words or less, respond to one of two questions provided. See Application Form for instructions.

C. Two letters of recommendation should be completed by persons unrelated to you who will attest to your motivation, character, and integrity. Letters should not refer to you by name but should include last 4 digits of your Social Security Number at the top of the page. Recommendations should not be from a family member, childhood friend who is not currently acquainted with your activities, or acquaintances who are not familiar with your experiences, activities, or future goals. Possible sources of recommendations include but are not limited to: the leadership of a volunteer group in which you are involved (FKSCC, FRG, American Red Cross, etc.); the teacher in a classroom where you volunteer; your supervisor at work; a teacher you have had in the past five years; the volunteer coordinator/pastor/teacher you have worked with at your church, etc.

F. OPTIONAL: Official college or vocational transcripts with an original signature or seal. No copies will be accepted.

G. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that a completed packet, as listed above, is mailed with sufficient postage. Postage-due mail will not be accepted and will be returned to the Post Office. **Hand-delivered applications will not be accepted.**

H. Include applicant's last 4 digits of the Social Security number on all application materials.

J. Incomplete and/or late applications are ineligible for consideration.

3. Scholarship Awards.

Scholarships awarded must be used during the school year immediately following receipt. **Funds available 15 August and must be claimed no later than 31 October.** Any funds not claimed by 31 October will be forfeited and revert back to the FKSCC Scholarship Program.

The Scholarship Committee will award funds directly to the institution of higher learning (not to the individual recipient) in the recipient's name upon verification of registration. Scholarship selections are made in March and scholarship recipients will be notified no later than April.
